NEW GRANT FOR MERTON ST/ MARKHAM WAY AND CLARENDON CRT

We are pleased to announce that Melbourne Water has again seen fit to fund our organisation this year.

We have an Administration Grant of \$697.84 to keep our group running and a grant of \$10,587 for works at Merton St/Markham Way, Altona Meadows, and Clarendon Crt, Seabrook.

Markham Way will be our focus for planting in 2015, with Newport Lakes Nursery growing 1000 plants specifically for this site.

Clarendon Crt, Seabrook, will be prepared for work in 2016, when 500 plants will be put in at this new site.

This grant, along with our Hobsons Bay Community Fund grant of \$1000, will make this our biggest year to date. So we are looking forward to many volunteer hours of fun along the Skeleton Creek sites ©

SUNDAY 22 FEB - MULCH SPREADING AT MERTON STREET, ALTONA MEADOWS

We will be spreading mulch and, depending on time, removing some weeds, guards and stakes.

We will be working at the Merton St end - near the timber seat Hobsons Bay Council installed for us.

Easiest entry is from Merton St, then walk along the shared path to the right, until you find our signin table (100m or so towards Selwood Place).

Please wear sturdy shoes, a hat, and gloves if possible. If you can bring a barrow, that would be good, if not, just bring yourself!

PLANTING REPORT

On 12 Feb, Denice and Angela went down to see how our Carinza Ave planting was getting on.

It is a pleasure to report that it is spreading in all directions and looks robust and healthy, despite the hot, dry weather.

This is one of the pleasing results from planting indigenous varieties. We were able to remove 120 stakes and 130 guards for future use at another site.

Unfortunately, we have had a few plants die. Overall, because we planted densely and used plants that spread - all is looking well.

The common reed Phragmites Australis (actually a large perennial grass) seems to be getting out of control in some places. To rid these 'invaders', we will see if we can paint them with weedicide.

Despite these minor setbacks, it is a planting we are proud of.
